



2018 Curator Wine Co. Riesling

Once part of an ancient sea bed, the thin loam soils sit above a substrate of red clay containing rose quartz and black mica schist fragments. In the heat of summer, cool breezes and low night temperatures promote long, slow ripening of fruit resulting in complex flavours with balanced acidity and fine, silky tannin.

Hand harvested with whole bunches gently pressed with only free run juice cool fermented under 14 degrees in stainless steel tanks over several weeks using wild yeast.

It is exquisitely composed and expressed, showing lemon pith, lime sorbet, apple and floral aromas on the nose. The palate is refined and focused, displaying excellent fruit purity and linear mouthfeel, backed by fine texture and perfectly pitched acidity. It is gracefully slim with an extremely long, mouth-watering finish. At its best: 2020 to 2032.
